Schedule

Bring along a blanket for the hay ride; remember to bring dressy casual clothes for the Candlelight Dinner on Saturday night. Also don't forget to bring your Bible, camera, pen, a notebook for taking notes, towels and washcloths, and toiletries including soap. You may bring your own fishing tackle and tennis racket if you are a serious fisherman or tennis player but we have some equipment here.
